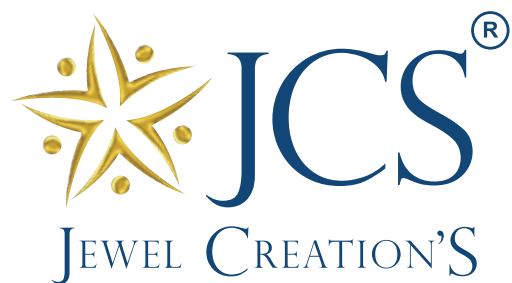

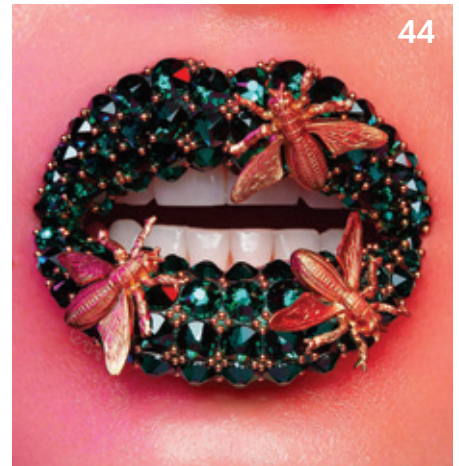

One of the most sensational designers of NYFW this year, Tokyo-based Tomo Koizumi rode to fame in one day with his debut collection that skyrocketed his Instagram from 2000 followers to over 24k followers in two days. Veteran actress, classical dancer, singer, choreographer and parliamentarian – this is Vyjayanthimala, South India’s artistic pride.

Her art blossomed while she was still a child, performing in front of the Pope at the age of 5. The Things We Do

We all do things to keep those we love close to us in our memories. And sometimes we like to have some external sign of that. I am no different. Except, what I did was not what Indian kids usually do in memory of their father.

I got a memorial bench installed for him in the park where we used to walk when he visited me. I remember how, during one of our walks, he pointed at a bench with an inscription and asked me about it. When I told him it was something people did in memory of their loved ones, he said “What a nice idea!”

I wrote about Appa’s bench a year ago. (I pause here because it reminds me how long it has been since we lost him. I tamp down on the memories and I continue). I recall his voice saying, “The show must go on.” After all, that was his approach when he lost his mum and my uncle was filming on location. When asked whether he should stop the shoot and come home,

I believe Appa told him to finish the shoot and come because she was already gone and, “The show must go on.”

He exhibited the same resilience when it was time for Amma’s cremation and he was in hospital with an angina attack. He said “This is my duty. I have to go,” and he did. A wonderful man who taught me more about love and honour than I realised.

So it was only fitting that I have an external sign of my gratitude. The bench has been my go-to place in moments of sadness. I would sit there for a few seconds and oddly I would find it difficult to concentrate on what I was complaining about. But I would lean against the words: “A quiet place to sit

me that would dissolve when I saw the bench. I didn't examine it too closely.

It was a lovely sunny day when I decided to go to the park. As I approached the bench, my heart sank. Someone had taken a sharp instrument and scored over the lettering. They had carved out the F-word on the wood. I came up short.

I felt an initial rush of hurt and anger. Why would someone attack Appa's bench? And then that knot of discomfort I felt every time I came to the bench unraveled itself into a thought.

It was only a matter of time before the bench was vandalized. I took a deep breath and the same voice reminded me – who would want to destroy such beautiful words? Just like you appreciated the loving heart behind the flowers that were arranged on the bench,

and remember the love and guidance... Until we meet again,” and somehow I would find my solace.

But it isn't only in sad moments that I have been there. Sometimes I would just go to see the bench and feel happy that someone was using it. I remember one day I went there with my childhood friend, someone had arranged wild flowers beautifully all over the bench. It was the most lovely and unexpected gesture from a stranger. And I thought, 'What a delightfully beautiful heart!'

That said, every time I went I would have a little knot of discomfort inside

you should pity the person who displayed such anger and venom towards this. Wasn't it obvious that they had neither love nor guidance in their lives? And wasn't that enough justification for them to destroy something that reminded them of what they did not have?

I felt the change within me as I distanced myself from the event. This was not about Appa's bench. It was not about me. It was about someone who was lost. With that, my usual logical approach stepped in.

I wondered if I should get sandpaper and sand the bench down. After all those hours in the workshop during my first year in college, it was a fairly simple thing for me to do. But the same voice reminded me: this was not my property. It was the Council's and for me to go sand it down without their permission made me no different than the vandal.

So I took a picture of the bench and went home and emailed them asking if I could go sand the bench down to remove the obscenity. I was so surprised to get a prompt response.

The lady who had worked with me over the 6 months to install the bench wrote back saying they were sorry it had happened and that they would send a team out to re-stain the bench. I was so grateful for the kindness not to mention the professional attitude. I mean, they have enough work to do without responding to a daughter's complaint about her father's memorial bench!

A few days later I got another email saying they have removed the slat that was damaged and that she would let me know once it was back. And today I got an email saying the slat had been replaced, along with a picture of the bench. A line in her email caught my attention and held it: "Over time, the difference in colour will blend." To my whimsical mind, it felt like an allusion to the way time works on loss.

Over time, our loss will blend into the fabric of our being, leaving behind wrinkles. And those wrinkles remind us of all the things we do to keep those we love close to us in our memories. ■

THE WAY RAKUL PREET SINGH HAS WORKED HER WAY UP THE LADDER TO WHERE SHE IS TODAY IS SOMETHING UNMISSABLE.



It has been a decade since she joined the film industry and the substantial roles she chooses to do now only go to show the effort she had to put in these. But, she believes that nothing is a challenge to her because she enjoys every choice and every step she takes.

My father instilled the discipline in me.

Rakul was born into a Punjabi family to an Army Officer. But she believes that her father was never a stringent parent: “I wouldn’t say strict. It was more about discipline than being strict. As I’m maturing, I realise the importance of discipline. My parents let my sibling and I do what we loved and they let go of us at the right age and time. Even today, we do not do anything to upset our parents, but that is out of respect and not out of fear,” says Rakul.

Rakul feels that being multi-faceted is a cakewalk to her all thanks to her parents. “I remember that from the age of six I was taken to various extra-curricular classes and had an extremely busy schedule. From karate and dance classes to vocals and sports, my brother and I have done it all. My father had multiple transfers and yet wherever we went, we had our classes sorted. You name a sport and we have done it. That’s how busy I have remained from a very young age. However, Rakul could never avert her eye from one sport – golf. She even participated in national golf tournaments when she was in high school. “I love the game even today. Golf is my ideal Sunday,” she says.

However, she was sure that that’s not what she wanted to pursue professionally. “Multi-tasking has become a habit I could and would never want to get rid of. Today I could easily multi-task and not feel any pressure on me,” she adds. She credits this dynamic exposure to her diverse profile as an actress.

“ SOME OF THE BIGGEST HITS OF MINE HAVE BEEN COMMERCIAL FILMS BUT THESE AREN'T SOMETHING I HAVE PUT TOO MUCH THOUGHT INTO. NOT BEING FROM A FILM BACKGROUND, I WOULD INITIALLY LET THE SCRIPTS CHOOSE ME AND NOT VICE VERSA. IN FACT I STILL BELIEVE IN THIS APPROACH.

I do not choose films, they choose me.

In the film industry, Rakul has worked a mixed bag of projects in various regions of cinema but there's something about the commercial films she chooses to do: "Be it Rarandoi Vedula Chudam or Theeran Adhigaram Ondru, the films may be seen in a commercial aspect but they were not commercial films. They have a very different sensibility and background. I may have worked with commercially successful heroes like Suriya sir but NGK is not a commercial film."

"Some of the biggest hits of mine have been commercial films but these aren't something I have put too much thought into. Not being from a film background, I would initially let the scripts choose me and not vice versa. In fact I still believe in this approach," she adds.

De De Pyaar De's Ayesha is very special to me.

One of Rakul's and Bollywood's biggest hits this year is her De De Pyaar De. Rakul's role as Ayesha won hearts easily. Her quirkiness, her simplicity, her modern thinking, and her strength was a refreshing character we almost never get to see a woman in. However, Rakul's role in the film made extreme sense and it was no run-of-the-mill storyline.

"I was lucky that the makers did not go by my image built in Bollywood at that point and believed in the fact that I could pull off Ayesha. Ayesha, however is a reflection of me in my real life - a confident, strong woman. The response for the film has been great and I thank God for that," adds Rakul. "It's that one big break that you start out with, where the film is appreciated, the role is appreciated and you are appreciated. I could have not asked for more. It was a new age concept and narrating a story

like this in a very slice-of-life, happy way is a huge advantage of the film. Also, the women characters, of both Tabu Ma'am and mine, have been built strong. What more could I ask for, right?" she beams.

Writers have become more conscious.

She also has a firm grasp on the progressive wave in films over the recent years: "The audience has evolved. They want to see better content with better roles for everyone and not just male actors. More content-driven cinema is working all over the country. People appreciate a role like Vanathi or Avanthika despite the failure or success of the film," she says. "There is a digital influx and viewers have the opportunity to get exposed to content in the west. That gives the audience a nudge to demand for stories that have a lot of variations," she remarks.

Nagarjuna sir and I always talk about food.

Rakul has previously worked with Naga Chaitanya in Rarandoi Vedula Chudam and has known actor Nagarjuna personally too. "He is a lovely person. He is non-starry and treats everyone equally human and respectful. We had a blast working for the film because we really believed in Manmadhudu 2. The two things we usually talk about are food and workout. We would always have serious discussions about where we would eat after the day's pack-up. It was a unique pleasure working with him," she adds.

I am extremely excited about Indian 2.

Along with Kamal Haasan, Siddharth, Vivek and Priya Bhavani Shankar, Rakul Preet Singh is now very much a part of director Shankar's Indian 2. Talking about the film, Rakul says, "I am extremely excited for the film and for working with Shankar sir. It has only

been three to four days since I have been shooting and I have shot with Kamal sir for the first time. Looking at him in that majestic makeover - he is just an amazingly committed and dedicated actor. I think he is the only actor in the entire film history who has done versatile roles right from a young age. It is an honour to work with an actor like him."

My role in Marjaavan is quite different.

Rakul says she has a contrasting role in Marjaavan as compared to her previous Bollywood film De De Pyaar De. The film is in the making with Siddharth Malhotra, Riteish Deshmukh, Tara Sutaria and Rakul Preet Singh in the lead. "My role in Marjaavan is amazing. It's a never-seen-before avatar for me and I have these really lengthy lines (laughs). I am looking forward for you all to see the first look," she says excitedly.

I still don't know if I'm an actor.

Rakul believes that success is ever an ongoing process: "I still don't know if I'm an actor. I am a woman who is doing what she loves and my everyday work is extremely fun for me. That is all I know. I am still the girl who lives her dream and enjoys every moment, one day at a time. I feel very special and grateful that people think of me as a successful actress but I still have a lot more to do."

Rakul's three-step approach to being confident

"Firstly, believe in yourself, whatever be your profession. Secondly take your time to figure yourself out; about what you want out of life. Finally, as per my Twitter description, build a life in such a way that you do not need a vacation from it." As the interview concludes, she adds, "Everyone is responsible for their own happiness." Golden words, aren't they? ■

Kodappan or Banana Flower Thoran

This delicious stir-fry is so nutritious! Chock-full of vitamins, proteins, minerals and fibre, banana flowers aid in lowering cholesterol levels and blood pressure among other astounding benefits.

WHAT YOU NEED

- 1** kodappan
- 1** onion, large
- 2** green chillies- 2
- 1 tsp** turmeric (½ for the turmeric water and ½ for the curry water (enough to prepare the turmeric

water and soak the banana flower)
salt to taste

For tempering

- ¼ tsp** mustard seeds
- 2** dried red chillies
- 1 stalk** curry leaves
- 5** shallots
- ¼ tsp** urad dal
oil as required

HOW TO MAKE

- 1.** Remove the outer layers of the banana flower and use only the yellow core.
- 2.** Prepare a mixture of water and turmeric powder.
- 3.** Dice the core finely and add into the turmeric water to aid in removing staining agents.

- 4.** Dice the onion and chillies.
- 5.** Remove the banana flower from the turmeric water, wash and drain.
- 6.** Mix the diced onion, banana flower, turmeric and chillies with salt and keep aside.
- 7.** Sauté from urad dal in oil until it turns light brown.
- 8.** Sputter some mustard seeds and sauté some dried red chillies, curry leaves and shallots.
- 9.** Add the diced banana flower into the sautéed spices and shallots.
- 10.** Mix well and cook covered on high flame.
- 11.** Remove the lid after a minute or two, add salt to taste and stir fry until all the excess water evaporates.



Cheera or Spinach Thoran



WHAT YOU NEED

- 1 bunch** spinach
- 1** onion, large (diced)
- A pinch** turmeric oil as required salt to taste

For the coconut paste

- ½** coconut, grated
- A pinch** cumin seeds
- 3** green chillies
- 1 stalk** curry leaves
- 3** shallots

For the tempering:

- 1 stalk** curry leaves
- 2** dried red chillies
- ¼ tsp** mustard seeds
- ¼ tsp** urad dal

HOW TO MAKE

- 1.** Separate the spinach stalks and leaves as both elements have different cooking times.
- 2.** Chop up the leaves and stalks and keep aside in separate bowls.
- 3.** Roughly grind shallots, curry leaves, green chillies, coconut and cumin seeds in the grinder.
- 4.** Sauté urad dal, mustard seeds, red chillies, curry leaves and diced onion in oil.
- 5.** Add the ground coconut mixture into the sautéed spices and stir.
- 6.** Add the chopped stalks, a little salt and cook covered till tender, on a low flame.
- 7.** Add the leaves and mix well to combine.
- 8.** Once the leaves wilt, transfer onto a serving plate.



Okra Sweet Pachadi



A lip-smacking combination of crunchy fried okra and sweet curd.

WHAT YOU NEED

- 1 cup** set curd
- 200 gms** okra
- ¼ tsp** turmeric
- 2 tbsp** powdered sugar (or as per taste)
- 2** green chillies
- oil as required
- salt to taste

For the coconut paste

- 2** dried red chillies
- 1 stalk** curry leaves

HOW TO MAKE

- 1.** Cut the okra and green chillies into thin circles.
- 2.** Add turmeric and salt to the okra and chillies, mix well and keep aside.
- 3.** Add the powdered sugar into the set curd and mix to combine.
- 4.** Fry the okra and chillies in oil until crisp and golden brown. Ensure that the okra does not burn.
- 5.** Spoon the fried okra into the curd and mix well.
- 6.** Temper red chillies and curry leaves in oil and pour over the okra and curd.

Chunks of ripe pumpkin, soft cowpeas and toasty coconut are the stars in this simple yet delectable and nutritious Onam staple.

WHAT YOU NEED

- 500 gms** pumpkin, ripe (cubed)
- 250 gms** cowpeas
- 2 pieces** jaggery, small (melt in water and keep ready for use - be careful to avoid the dregs while pouring the jaggery in)
- oil as required
- salt to taste

For the coconut paste:

- 1** coconut, small (grated) - use half for the paste and half for dry fry*
- 4-5** green chillies
- Handful** shallots
- 2 stalks** curry leaves
- ½ tsp** cumin seeds
- A pinch** turmeric powder

For tempering and garnish:

- 3** red chillies
- 1 stalk** curry leaves
- ½ tsp** mustard seeds
- coconut (grated)*

HOW TO MAKE

- 1.** Wash the cowpeas well and pressure cook for 4 whistles.
- 2.** Open the cooker and add the cubed pumpkin and 2 of the green chillies.
- 3.** After one whistle, immediately let out the steam so that the pumpkin remains soft, yet chunky. Let sit covered on low heat.
- 4.** Prepare the coconut mixture in a grinder by adding half of the grated coconut, the remaining green chillies, curry leaves, shallots, cumin seeds and a pinch of turmeric. Grind



- till a smooth paste is achieved.
- 5.** Open the pressure and add this mixture into the pumpkin and cowpeas.
- 6.** Add salt and jaggery according to taste.

- 7.** Into a kadai, add the remaining coconut and dry-fry until it turns a golden brown. Add into the pressure cooker. The coconut adds a lovely texture to the curry. Stir to

combine and switch off the stove.

- 8.** Temper some mustard seeds, curry leaves, shallots and dried red chillies in some oil and pour atop the curry. Serve hot. ■

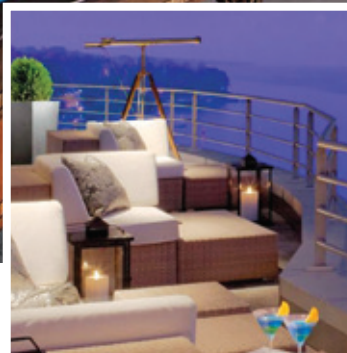
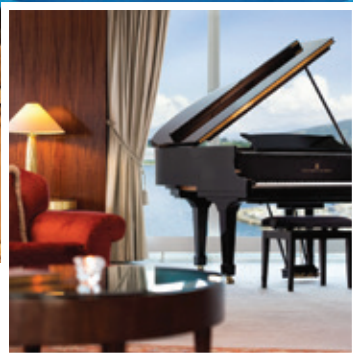

than-life set, a huge star cast and a lot more to look out for. Even with these odds in his favour however, Sujeeth still fails to engage the audience.

Prabhas is truly the only saving grace of this action-drama film. Since 'Bahubali', Prabhas has undoubtedly been enjoying an enormous onscreen presence. He is a visual treat here too, and his role in this film has been layered well, but the storyline has not done justice to this exceptional star when he can be seen giving his everything to make it work. On the other hand, Shraddha Kapoor's role is not what the trailer promised. She is a well-dressed cop who, like any other actress, needs to be saved by the hero. Directors have moved way ahead in writing better women characters and we still seem to be stuck back in time with this film.

The antagonists are many, but actor Chunky Pandey stands out from among them all. Having said that, despite reasonable screenspace provided to them, actors Neil Nithin Mukesh, Shraddha Kapoor, Chunky Pandey, Mandhira Bedi to name a few, hardly register in the minds of the audience. The storyline has way too many twists that seem to have been tossed in there for the sake of it and feels too tiring. It is not the lack of logic we blame; but the action sequences need to stay crisp and sharp for an entertainer like this. Action frames have been remarkably shot in terms of cinematography, yet feel exhausting with a more exhausting narrative.

Unfortunately these action sequences and unnecessary twists take up most of the screentime making us wonder when the film would even end. What a waste of talent, time and energy. We would be happier if we get to see Prabhas and his great effort gets used efficiently.

VERDICT: Prabhas is definitely a visual treat but not at the cost of lousy narration.

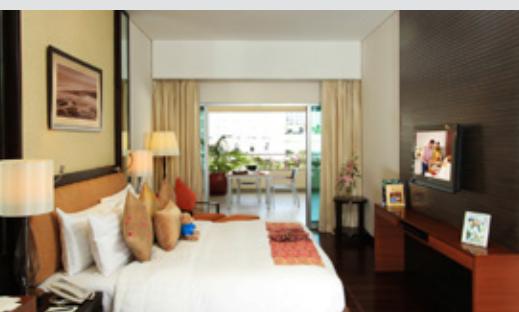
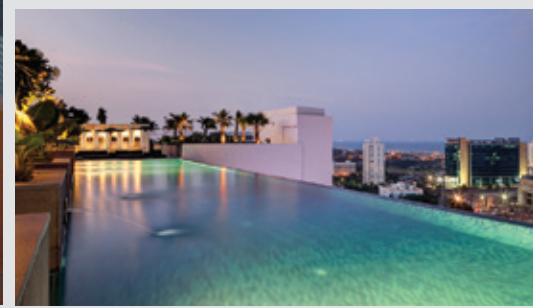

FOR ONCE, A REMAKE DOES JUSTICE

Three independent working women are living their best life when they come across three men at a music festival. Meera Krishnan (Shraddha Srinath) hits Aadvik (Arjun Chidambaram), the son

of a politician on his head with a bottle and escapes with her two other friends Fami (Abhirami) and Andrea. The girls then face a series of threats from the boys including the abduction and molestation of Meera. That is when lawyer Bharath Subramaniam (Ajith) steps in to help the girls put across the importance of a simple yet powerful word – NO.

Definitely one of the most important topics to discuss in our society today, the message of ‘NO just means NO’ strongly resonates in this narrative. H. Vinoth too has managed to give a remake as powerful as the original, Bollywood’s ‘PINK’. Also, to the Tamil audience, this is a sensitive issue which no director has dared to touch upon.

Vinoth further explores through mere frames the importance of a woman’s freedom. He also questions the character assassination of a “modern woman” who chooses to drink, smoke, and laugh and makes friends with men. The talented cinematographer Nirav Shah packs each frame with moving and deeply reflective moments. The screenplay beautifully paces as the impactful courtroom drama begins.

Ajith as Bharath Subramaniam is an unsurprising winner. With his impeccable dialogue delivery during the court room scenes, he manages to relay a crucial message to an audience who has not-so-frequently exposed to something as imperative as consent. A fight scene joins this version but it does not distract the storyline. Yuvan’s background score adds to the pace of the film.

Shraddha Srinath manages to deliver a decent performance, but Abhirami performs exceedingly well as Fami. Rangaraj Pandey as Lawyer Subramaniam lends a substantial performance too and the audience would enjoy watching his argumentative self come alive in this character. Andrea and Arjun do justice to their parts as well.

Both Vinoth and Ajith earn a salute each for taking up a sensitive issue to deliver a message that actually matters to our society today.

VERDICT: The haunting truth depicted by full-bodied performances. Not to be missed.
